Cell City Scoring Guide

<u>Purpose:</u> Pretend you are a guide leading a tour through a museum. You will create a map using each cell outline to guide your tourist and describe the functions of an animal and a plant cell. You will need to label the cells clearly.

<u>Background:</u> All living things are made of cells. Plant and animals cells share many of the same parts, but differ in some ways. Inside both plants and animals cells is a jelly-like fluid called cytoplasm, within which other cell parts float. The part that directs the cells activities is the nucleus. A cell is full of many mitochondria, which produce power for the cell. Each cell also has several small vacuoles, which are sacs that store food and water inside the cell.

The outer layer of an animal cell is the cell membrane. It has pores that allow some material to pass in and out of the cell. In a plant cell, the cell wall surrounds the cell membrane and gives the cell support. Only plant cells have small parts called chloroplasts. Inside chloroplasts, plants store chlorophyll, which help the cell make its own food from light, water, and carbon dioxide.
