- 1. Break the word into syllables.
- 2. Identify and graph all the sounds.
- 3. Look for patterns.
- 4. Divide compound words.

- 5. Underline prefixes and suffixes.
- 6. Look for root words.

Latin Roots

- terr=land or earth
- ver=truth
- tain and ten=hold

<u>Homophones</u>-words that sound the same but are spelled differently and have different meanings.

- Remember silent "e" goes back to make a vowel long ex: outtake
- Remember double consonants help "protect" short vowels ex: metallic
- Check for blended sounds like ar, or, ur, oy, ng, tch, sh, ch, th
